Professional Biography

Special Agent Keith G. Medford began his professional career at Harding University, receiving a B. A. in Journalism in December of 1976. He received an MBA from Texas Tech University in 1982 with a concentration in statistics. In 1982 SA Medford was hired by Bank of the Southwest in Houston, Texas where he worked in the Asset/Liability Management and Strategic Planning Department. After becoming Mbank, Bank of the Southwest was bought by Bank One. At Bank One, SA Medford rose the rank of Vice President in the Capital Management Department where he was responsible for the short term investments of many of the Bank's corporate customers.

SA Medford began his law enforcement career with the FBI in 1990 and has been with the Bureau for 14 years. His first assignment was in the Little Rock Field Division working white-collar crime investigations. There he worked a variety of bank fraud, wire fraud and securities fraud cases. In 1995 he was transferred to the Los Angeles Field Division, Long Beach Resident Agency working white-collar crime and civil rights investigations. In 1997 he was transferred to the Houston Field Division, Special Operations Group where he served as a Bureau Pilot in Command. In 2001 he joined the Cyber Crime squad where he is currently the Houston InfraGard Coordinator. InfraGard is an information sharing and analysis effort serving the interests and combining the knowledge base of a wide range of members. At its most basic level, InfraGard is a partnership between the FBI and the private sector. InfraGard is an association of businesses, academic institutions, state and local law enforcement agencies, and other participants dedicated to sharing information and intelligence to prevent hostile acts against the United States.
