

LTJG Brian Sadler

A native of Winslow Arizona, LTJG Sadler started his Coast Guard career as an enlisted person attending boot camp at Cape May N.J. in March 1996. After graduating from Electronics Technician (ET)-A school, he was stationed at Electronics Support Unit (ESU) Portsmouth 1996 -1997. In his next duty station, Mr. Sadler served onboard the Coast Guard Cutter Midgett (a 378 ft High Endurance Cutter) home-ported in Seattle (1997-2000). The highlight of the Midgett tour was a deployment to the Persian Gulf, as part of a US Naval battle group, enforcing UN sanctions. From 2000-2003 Mr. Sadler served as an ET-A school instructor at TRACEN Petaluma. While attached to TRACEN Petaluma he was a member of the TRACEN Fire Department, Leadership and Management School (LAMS) instructor, member of the Commandant's Leadership Advisory Council (LAC), and selected to attend Officer Candidate School (OCS). Currently LTJG Sadler is a Port State Marine Inspector stationed at Sector Houston/Galveston.
