Francisco Sanchez is liaison to County Judge Ed Emmett, director of the Harris County Office of Homeland Security & Emergency Management (OHSEM) and serves as the organization's public information officer. OHSEM is responsible for regional disaster preparedness and response in the nation's third largest county.

Sanchez joined Harris County in 2004 and was lead public information officer during the local response to both Hurricanes Katrina and Rita in 2005. Most recently, he led the Harris County Joint Information Center operations during Hurricane Ike and the highly active 2008 hurricane season.

Sanchez is spearheading a nationally recognized effort to integrate the Joint Information Center concept into local emergency response efforts. The initiative integrates technology and best practices to deliver timely and accurate information to decision makers, stakeholders, media and the public during times of crisis.
