***It was on THAT job that he got a call that a 62 yr old woman had collapsed. She was slumped on the bench with her daughter holding her up. She had a history of heart disease and diabetes. He established the woman did not have a pulse and got her to the floor...directing everyone: getting someone to call 911, getting someone to get the AED,***

*getting a coworker to start compressions while he gave breaths. The woman received three shocks when prompted by the AED. They continued CPR until EMS arrived and she was transported. (she passed away 12 hrs later)*

*Russ talked to me about how complacent we get when receiving training because we think it will never happen during our watch. I was really impressed when he told me the details of his response: remembering to ask if she had a pacemaker before applying the AED pads, checking to see if she had eaten and clearing her airway, being considerate to the daughter and telling her he had to open her mother's blouse for the AED. He said it was the most exhausting, stressful experience of his life.*

Mike Mallon, Chairman, introduced Mark Wright with Brookfield Properties, Speaker of the Day.
