*Department, responded to the roof of the garage. Seeing the individual sitting on the railing he communicated with the individual in an attempt to get him away from the edge of the roof. The individual indicated he did not want assistance and in a farewell gesture pulled the hood of his sweatshirt over his head and started to lean backwards over the edge. Officer Ochoa grabbed the individual preventing him from falling, and made sure the individual was assisted by medical personnel. This act of bravery, without regard for his personal safety saved this individual's life. It gives me great pride to nominate Security Officer Jaime Ochoa as ASIS Houston Chapter Officer of the month.*
